Newfane Heritage Festival, October 7 & 8, 2017

**Festival Hours - 10am-4pm - Saturday and Sunday.** Exhibitors are expected to be there during these hours. No exceptions!

**Exhibitor Registration** - in Food Tent - Exhibitors must register before beginning set-up.  
Friday, 2pm - 6pm .... Saturday beginning at 6:30am.

**At Registration, you will receive:**

Space Assignment  
Parking Permit  
Festival Information  
Exhibitor Tag (potty button)  
Complimentary Coffee Coupons.

**Vehicles**

Do NOT park on the grass of the Common to unload or load your craft items and display!

Use CAUTION on all streets around the Common. Remember! These are public roads used by locals and tourists.

Use EXTRA caution if you park along busy Rte 30 to unload or load.

**All vehicles must be cleared from the area BEFORE 9:25am.** No vehicles are to be in the craft area during the festival. Streets are blocked to traffic in the festival area.

*Note: the Festival begins at 10am, but visitors have been coming early. For the safety of all, vehicles must be cleared from the area BEFORE 9:25am.*

**Parking** - During the festival, parking for one vehicle per exhibitor is provided. See map for location of Exhibitor Parking. Under no circumstances are exhibitors to park on the Common across Route 30.

☞☞ **Cell Phone & Wi-Fi Service** is improving on Newfane Common. There is good cell reception for AT&T, and possibly for other carriers as well. Secure Wi-Fi access is provided courtesy of Southern Vermont Cable. Plus, Newfane Church has secure Wi-Fi, although you have to be close to the church building to access it. Log-on passwords are available for both networks.

☞ **WARNING:** The Common sometimes experiences strong wind gusts. SECURE YOUR TENT!

**No Dogs** - Dogs have become an increasing problem at the Festival. We will be doing whatever we can to discourage visitors from bringing dogs into the Festival. Please help. Do not bring your dog.

**Other Information:**

Windham County Sheriff provides ALL NIGHT SECURITY on Friday and Saturday.  
Exhibitors must provide their own tent, tables, chairs, and display stands.  
Festival volunteers cannot provide set-up or take-down help.

**CLEAN-UP** - Take everything home when you leave, including cardboard, bubbly wrap, scraps of papers, and any **other trash**. We are all volunteers and we do not appreciate cleaning up the Common after you leave.
